- 2023-24 Budget Draft
 - o Carryover from this year will impact next year's budget
 - Most \$ will go through MemberHub, which will simplify things
 - Goal to eliminate Venmo and Paypal and be as cash-less and check-less as possible
 - Will vote on final budget at T123 Open House
- Debit Card!
 - NCPTA just approved the use of debit cards by PTA; will eliminate the need for the reimbursement process for larger purchases
- End of year budget procedures
 - Any remaining invoices to be paid or reimbursements need to be submitted asap: http://bit.ly/OCEPTAchecks
 - 2022-23 financial audit will be completed in June/July, will then be filed with NCPTA
 - Thank you to Kelly Joyner and Kari Hughes (audit committee)
 - Welcome Loretto Ewen to the audit committee for 2023-24
- Considerable carryover: Julie will create restricted funds categories to deal with this carryover based on conversation with NCPTA rep
- The 2023-24 planned budget is scaled back 23% across the board regarding income, and we haven't had the planned big items the last few years that we used to have (no need for technology line items since COVID) - continue our goal of not aiming to make money in all things
